Dear Parishioners,

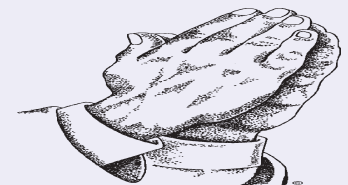
