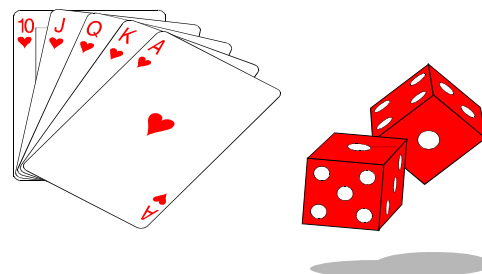


PLEASE TAKE A FEW MINUTES TO REMEMBER THE MILITARY MEN AND WOMEN AND THEIR FAMILIES.

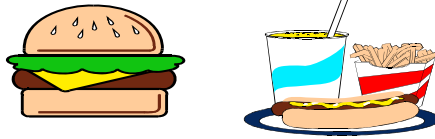


Youth Retreat Hike
