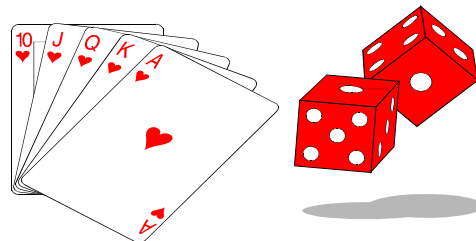
Food Pantry

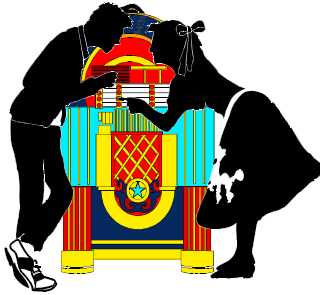
