Dearest Parishioners.

Today is the celebration of Trinity Sunday the first Sunday after Pentecost.

On this day, the church rejoices in the impenetrable mystery that God is triune (three-in-one) -Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. How the Lord can be one God in three distinct persons is completely beyond the ability of any human to understand.
